### CJS Focus and In Depth features

Published quarterly and offered as a supplement to CJS Weekly as well as appearing in full online. Each edition focuses on a different area of the sector and is in association with a relevant organisation. The Focus is primarily an information resource for our readers; the aim is to introduce a new area of the sector and to provide valuable information thereby increasing the current knowledge of our readers. We produce two editions on Volunteering each year. 2017 editions were Fundraising and Promotion and, Forestry and Arboriculture. During 2018 subjects are Greenspace, urban sites as opposed to rural ones, and Employability with information on career paths and application hints.

## Professional Training and Events

**Short Courses:** professional training events of one to ten days in length on all subjects from NVC & ecological ID skills to ranger training, community involvement, first aid certification, practical skills e.g. chainsaw & brushcutter to environmental education courses. A fully searchable rolling programme of training courses and professional events happening across the country. Sub-divided according to event type to make it easier to find what you're searching for if you're not entirely sure what additional skills you need.

**Events:** these are professional events such as annual conferences and seminars which are not necessarily training opportunities but still of great interest (and excellent networking opportunities).

**Surveys and Fieldwork:** Opportunities to gain skills whilst helping with data gathering, now includes citizen science.
